Welcome to our Caravan and Motorhome Club Certificated Location (CL) and



Keal Lodge Park affiliated to Tranquil Parks and Premier Parks – it's great to have you with us!

We hope that you have a wonderful and peaceful stay. We will do all that we can to ensure that this is the case. Office hours are displayed on the office door but you may well see us around the

site at other times. Please don't hesitate to let us know if we can be of help.

Site Information & Facilities for Both Sites

<u>GRASS AROUND YOUR PITCH</u> – To help us maintain the site and make mowing easier, please keep surplus electricity leads, water pipes, awning guide ropes, clothes airers etc. within your gravel pitch. We obviously accept that if it becomes very windy storm straps need to be used, but hopefully they can be removed when not needed.

<u>CARS</u> – Once you have pitched, please park on the car park area to the left of the sites.

<u>ELECTRICITY</u> – Please connect to hook-up corresponding to your numbered pitch. (When cold, please can we advise you that the use of water heating and heaters to be used on gas, which is more efficient, and there will be a lower chance of the power being over-loaded.)

THE WATER SYSTEM – The site is metered. The tap is numbered for each pitch. Only turn the <u>tap one revolution</u> at the start of your stay. <u>When the aquaroll is full</u>, please just check that there are <u>no leaks</u> from <u>any connection</u>. On the **morning of your departure** turn tap off and let your aquaroll go down by use, again so we are not throwing away full tanks of water. **In frosty/very cold weather** please **fill the aquaroll**, then **turn the tap off**.

HOT WATER SYSTEMS – Before departing please DO NOT release hot water from your unit onto the grass.

TOILET DISPOSAL POINT – Use Green fluids please as we are on septic tanks. Both sites have a flushing toilet with a tap for rinsing, the CL disposal point is located to right of path leading to the bungalow driveway. The Keal Lodge Park disposal point is located in bottom corner of the site. Please make sure that you leave it as you would like to find it. **PLEASE DO NOT PUT WET WIPES IN YOUR TOILET**.

<u>MV POINT</u> – Situated to the left of the driveway up to Keal Lodge Park. Please leave the area hosed down.

DUSTBINS – RECYCLING –On both sites the bins are located at the toilet emptying point: **DO NOT LEAVE large packaging and polystyrene from new purchases**.

DRIVING ON SITE - WALKING SPEED ONLY AT ALL TIMES PLEASE

DOGS – We aim to maintain the peaceful and friendly nature of our site. A maximum of two well disciplined, quiet dogs per unit will be welcome (more by prior consent). Please keep your pets on a lead whilst on the site as it is important that dogs do not disturb other guests. Cleanliness – Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs anywhere on our premises and putting the bag in the bins provided. The pedestrian gate to the Dog Exercise Field is off the car parking area into the field where you may exercise your dog freely.

INTERNET WI-FI CONNECTION – We have complimentary internet connection – on arrival your access codes, user name & password, are printed on the 'Arrival information for your pitch' sheet.

HARDSTANDING and GROUNDSHEETS – Any kind of groundsheets can be used within the hardstanding pitches, but we would ask that **no groundsheets** be used on any grassed area.

WINDBREAKS – Can we please ask that if using a windbreak, this must be kept within your pitch and not encroach on neighbouring pitches.

BBQs – No low level or ground BBQs. Please do not put hot lids on grass.

<u>NIGHT LIGHTS</u> – Lights on the electric bollards and over toilet disposal point stay on all night, the lights down the driveway are on until approximately midnight.

FIRE EXTINGUISHERS & FIRE BELL – CL - Located inside Information Centre and bell on the outside of same. Keal Lodge Park – 1st located on fence at toilet disposal point & 2nd along tree lined fence near wooden gate to CL, and Fire Bell also by 2nd extinguisher.

EMERGENCY SERVICES TO ARRIVE AT – Our full details are KEAL LODGE, BACK LANE, DEEPING ST. JAMES, PETERBOROUGH, PE6 8RT. TELEPHONE 01778 346946. A payphone is in the information centre, Free Emergency calls. Details are displayed at Fire Extinguisher points.

INFORMATION CENTRE – On the CL open at all times, the lighting is automatic on a PIR sensor. Details of local shops, restaurants and places to visit are available in a file. There is also a library. Jigsaw puzzles are in cupboard nearest the window. **Maps and walk sheets are available, please return after use.** Further walks are available from the office on request. DEPARTURE FROM THE SITE – Please could we remind you to ONLY use route to arrive and depart site given on our website and in the Caravan & Motorhome Club Book. PLEASE ARRIVE AND DEPART BY WAY OF STOWGATE ROAD AND NOT USING THE VILLAGE ROADS WITH YOUR CARAVAN OR MOTORHOME.

On departure, turn LEFT out of the site and LEFT onto Stowgate Rd. At cross-roads turn LEFT, continue 1 m. At main road (B1525) turn *RIGHT & in 1.5 m you will pick up the A1175 Market Deeping Bypass. Or *turn LEFT towards Market Deeping passing The Goat Inn on the right. We make this point because while you are staying here, your best route to Deeping. St. James and Market Deeping is to turn right out of the site. The Caravan and Motorhome Club policy is to provide routes which, where possible, keep caravan traffic out of the built-up areas or narrow roads, therefore Satellite Navigation systems are not always useful for final destination directions.

TRANSPORT

LOCAL BUS SERVICES

Whilst there is no bus stop immediately adjacent to the site, there are frequent buses from Market Deeping to local destinations. It is possible to park your car in the car park off Godsey Lane (near Poundstretchers, Market Deeping) for a nominal fee for the full day and enjoy a trip by bus.

Destinations include Bourne, Peterborough, Stamford and Spalding. This is perfect for those of you fortunate enough to have a bus pass!

101/102 for Bourne and Peterborough

For both directions the 101 leaves from Church Street and the 102 departs from the Market Place. Alternatively, if you fancy some gentle exercise, the nearest bus stop is at Horsegate for the 102. This is about a 15 minute walk from the site.

203 for Spalding and Stamford

For both directions the buses depart from the Market Place and Horsegate (see above).

TRAINS
